

The British New Testament Conference 2016
The University of Chester
1st—3rd September 2016

THE VENUE

The conference will take place on the Main Campus (now called the Parkgate Road Campus), located on Parkgate Road (the main entrance is called the Exton Entrance). The campus conference venues are all very close to one another. The postcode for the University is CH1 4BJ.

Delegates may arrive from 3pm on Thursday. Registration will take place either in Binks (where the plenaries will take place) or Grosvenor (the accommodation block) to be confirmed. The buildings are very close to each other. The conference will kick off with a reception at 5.30pm in the Small Hall with Dinner at 6.30pm in White's Dining Hall. Publishers' Displays will be in the Small Hall.

The conference ends after lunch on Saturday. Lunch is from 1pm-2pm. On Thursday and Friday we will invite you to put your name down to share taxis back to the station.

TRAVELLING TO CHESTER

Chester is easily accessible by Rail, Coach, and Road.

Rail

It is about a 20 minute walk from Chester railway station to the campus. There should be plenty of taxis outside the station, which will cost about £5. Ask for the main or Parkgate Road campus. A map is attached if you wish to walk.

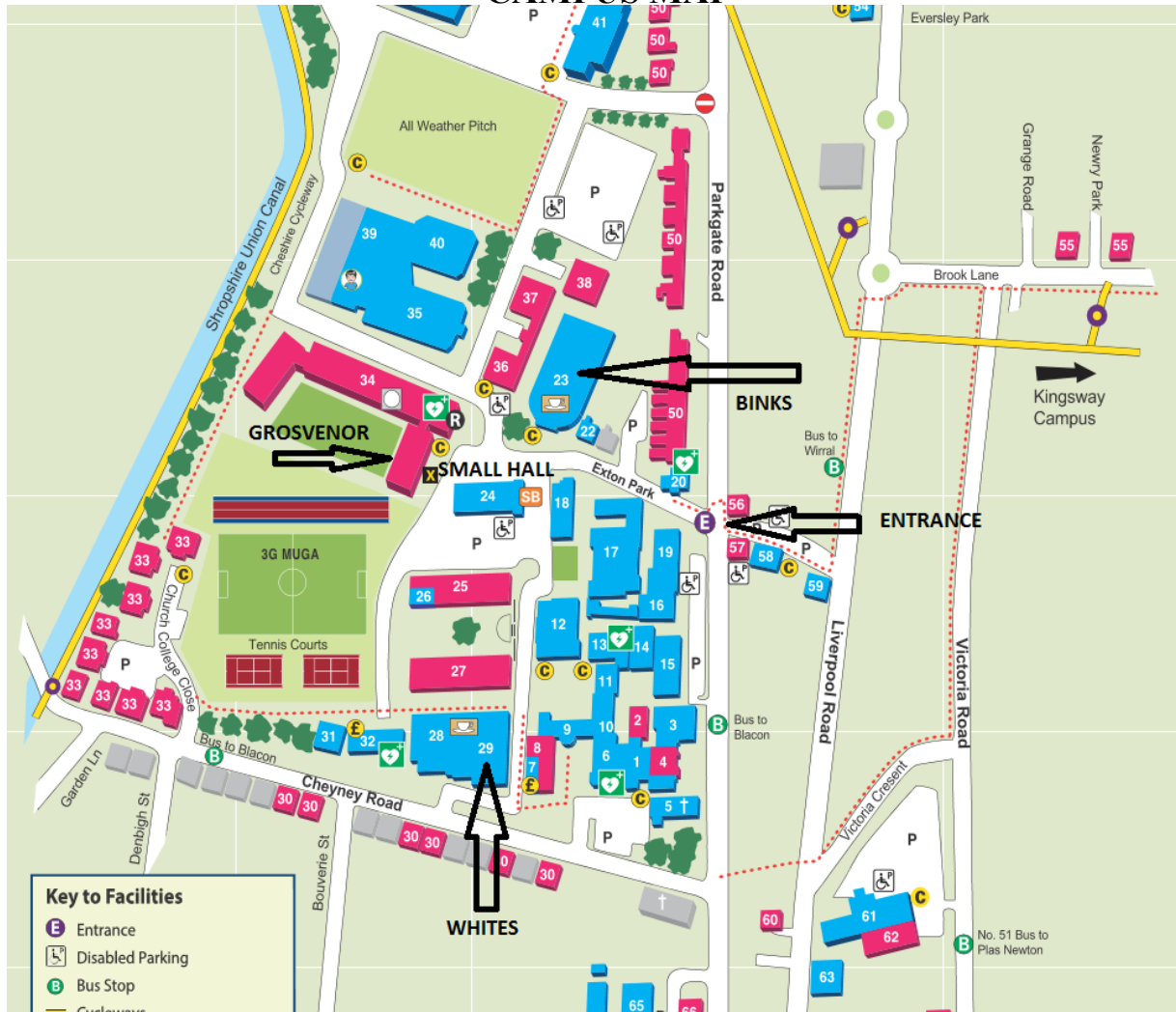
Coach

Chester has regular National Express Coach services. The bus station is in town and is a 10-15 walk from the campus.

Road

Chester is very close to both the M53 and M56. You should be able to find the campus with your satnav (CH1 4BJ). There is some parking available on campus.
